It has been brought to my attention about a consultation due to close today (Thursday 10 December 2020) regarding the Scoping Opinion consultation from PINS in view of a National Rail Freight Terminal for Hinckley.

I regret that I was not made aware that such a consultation was taking place until late in this process; may I enquire as to the reason behind this? I was surprised to note this consultation deadline for such a major project which, although situated in a neighbouring constituency, will impact Bosworth especially in the Hinckley and Burbage areas.
