Augean South Limited intends to submit an application for a Development Consent Order for the alteration and construction of hazardous waste and low level radioactive waste facilities at the East Northants Resource Management Facility, Stamford Road, Northamptonshire.

*The Project*

The ENRMF site is an established operational landfill site which accepts hazardous waste and low level radioactive waste. The site also includes an established waste treatment and recovery facility. The application for a new Development Consent Order will be for an extension in the area and timescales for the operation of the site including an extension to the west of the existing site and increasing the throughput of the waste treatment and recovery facility.

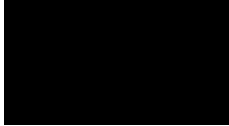
