The Application was made to the Secretary of State for the Department of Leveling (by Indusing and Communities (via the Paramin Insepectates) under sections 30 and 37 of the Famining Act 2006 on September 2021 and was accepted by the Famining Insepectoral to a September 2021. The Application has been given the Planning Inspectorale reference number WS010005.

SUMMARY OF THE SCHEME

The Application seeks consent for the alteration of existing and the construction of new facilities for the recovery and disposal of hazardou and the disposal of low level radioactive waste at the East Northants Resource Management Facility (ENRMF) Stamford Road, Northamptons 6XX. ("The Scheme")
