Dear Andrew,

Please be aware that I have now taken over from Kate as the Operations Manager for this project. Please also accept my apology for the late reply to your email.

As the Planning Inspectorate has already advised, we cannot confirm whether the project is an NSIP until we receive the application documents. There are several tests on the definition and threshold in s30 of the Planning Act (2008) which the application documents must evidence. The scoping process is done neutrally so it will not confirm the position either way. However, in the meantime we will continue to progress it in good faith.

I appreciate that this does not provide the comfort you are seeking. The Planning Inspectorate is mindful of the impact of s160 and the criminal sanction impact. In that regard, the judgment in the judicial review of the Heysham DCO may assist, where Mr Justice Turner stated that even if the project was not an NSIP then he would not have granted the challenge as the development consent process is thorough and comprehensive and a fair process by which to consider an application for a scheme such as that and the process did not need to be rerun.

I am happy to arrange a further pre-application meeting if that would assist.
