Subject: Development Consent Order of the Thames Tideway Tunnel

Hello there,

We have received further consultation on the Thames Tideway Tunnel. In this instance, the Council has been asked specifically if the applicant has satisfied:

The duty to consult
The duty to consult the local community
The duty to publicise

The start of the Thames Tideway Tunnel (Acton Pumping Works) is situated about 4miles from the Borough boundary. It is unlikely the physical works would have any impact on the borough. We therefore have no objections or concerns regarding the extent of the consultation on the Tideway.

One area that does need clearing up is whether the Tideway would result in any knock-on impacts on the existing sewage infrastructure or drainage regime for West London; particularly with regards to Mogden sewage works which although outside the Borough (in LB Hounslow) serves a large area of Hillingdon. I understand this an existing approved plan for upgrading Mogdens so it does not appear that funding for new infrastructure in West London suffers to make way for the Tideway. However, it would be useful to have clarification about the wider drainage implications for Hillingdon (positive or negative) due to the Tideway proposals.

It would be useful to have a contact at the Tideway project who may be able to answer these questions.
