Dear Sir/Madam,

I live on [REDACTED] which is near the proposed tunnel site in SW6. I went to the meeting on 20th November, but couldn't stay long enough to speak, so I would like to highlight some of the reasons that I am opposed to the tunnel location on the Carnwath Road Site.

I am appalled that Thames Water would serious consider using a densely populated site for this purpose. This area has a large population of many different kinds of residents housed in a variety of housing stock. Most people have no alternative housing situations, i.e., country homes, etc where they can go to escape the drilling noise, pollution and traffic that will dramatically increase 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There are many schools in the immediate area, where thousands of children will be subjected to noise and dangerous traffic as they go to and from schools. And Hammersmith and Fulham council proposes to renovate one of the school sites to build a large secondary school for 800 boys that will add to the construction and traffic at first and then subject these children to the same dangerous situation.

I feel that this site is better suited to the Barn Elms site where there are less people. I hope that you will consider my concerns and the concerns of my neighbours who were able to speak at the meetings.
