1 Response to London Borough of Newham Local Impact Report

1.1 Response

- 1.1.1 We are pleased to note that the London Borough of Newham recognises that both Abbey Mills Pumping Station and Beckton Sewage Treatment Works play a strategically important role in London's sewerage infrastructure and that there is a broad consensus among local stakeholders that the Thames Tideway Tunnel project works are required and that these are appropriate sites.
- 1.1.2 We are also pleased to note that the Council has considered the implications of the local effects of the works to construct the project at both sites and concluded that the overall balance between impacts and benefits of the project as a whole is compliant with the [National Policy Statement for Waste Water](#) and supported by strategic and local planning policies. We note that this support for the project is conditional on the use of Abbey Mills Pumping Station as a reception site, as proposed, rather than a drive site. This is entirely consistent with our position that Chambers Wharf should be preferred over Abbey Mills Pumping Station as the main drive site for the main tunnel in East London. That position is set out in our response to the Local Impact Report and written representations of the London Borough of Southwark.
- 1.1.3 We do not intend to submit any further comments on this Local Impact Report.
