I understand the Panel has asked whether the PLA wishes to participate in a discussion of s. 127 and s.138. The Panel's consideration is appreciated. As I said in my letter below, the PLA did not have any representations to make concerning the proposed acquisition of its operational land. However, yesterday it was notified of additional land take proposals for four parcels of land. These changes have still to be checked against the book of reference but I can confirm that the PLA will attend tomorrow to make representations about them.

We will examine the proposals in case there is any procedural point to raise.

Otherwise in relation to s.127 and s.138, the PLA may wish to respond to what others say.

PLA will attend on Friday in relation to s. 131 and s.132; I should flag up that related to the use of open space land is the PLA's objection to the proposed power to extinguish or suspend rights of navigation.

On compulsory purchase river-wide, the PLA has issues concerning supposedly temporary structures and land take and also ownership and control of structures in or adjoining the river.
