LDT wishes to advise the ExA that it wishes to attend the Compulsory Acquisition Hearing meeting tomorrow (17th January 2014). We would like to reserve the right to speak at the meeting in order to respond to any possible comments or representations made at the meeting that may affect our operation. However, we do not intend to make any detailed submissions at the meeting as there is currently no agreement to the statement of common ground and other matters with the Applicant, and therefore LDT feels submitting evidence at tomorrow's hearing would be premature.
