Dear Sirs

I am writing to provide a summary of Network Rail's representations made during the hearings held between Feb 3 and 5, Network Rail is hopeful that agreed terms can be reached on the terms of protective provisions, asset protection agreements and an interface agreement. Pending resolution of these matters, Network Rail continues to have concerns about articles 9, 51, 53 and 56 of the draft Order and the proposed terms of the protective provisions contained in Schedule 16 to the draft order dated Feb 3 intended to be put forward to the Examining Authority on February 12. In particular Network Rail is concerned that its operational land is protected from unfettered rights of compulsory acquisition.

The views expressed on behalf of Network Rail at the hearings are set out in full in Network Rail's written representation dated November 4.
