## Cambridge Waste Water Treatment Plant Initial Response to WW010003-000815 Procedural Decision 10<sup>th</sup> of August 2023

Dear Deborah,

I am writing further to our letter of 08<sup>th</sup> September and confirming our submission of additional information and updated documentation as requested in response to the Examining Authority's (ExA's) Procedural Decision published by the Planning Inspectorate on the 10<sup>th</sup> of August 2023.

The Applicant notes the ExA's comments in the Rule 6 Letter in respect of the Applicant's submissions of 18 July and as requested, the Applicant has included in its submissions of 29 September in response to the Procedural Decision all of those documents submitted on 18 July in the formats requested by the ExA. Those versions have been consolidated with the updates made to address the matters identified by the ExA in its Procedural Decision. All changes to the documentation are summarised in the table below and in the updated 'Guide to the Application', document APP-003 which contains all document references and version numbers.
