Dear Sirs

I am writing to object to the above proposal in the strongest terms and on the following grounds:

- 1 It is entirely unnecessary, as the existing plant is adequate for current and foreseeable needs. Cambridge cannot support the massive expansion which might require a new site for waste water disposal, as there is already insufficient water for the city's needs.
- 2 It would be extremely expensive - as a resident of the city, I object to my taxes being spent on this work.
- 3 The work involved would be disruptive, causing pollution and congestion.
- 4 It would be damaging to the Green Belt area of Honey Hill.
- 5 At this time, when we are committed to preventing climate change and supporting biodiversity, it would be contrary to both objectives.

I trust this proposal will be rejected.
