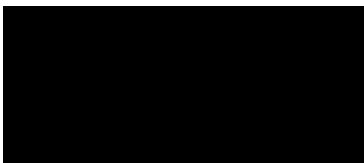
Comments on the responses to the LIR by Save Honey Hill
