We have reviewed the updated arboricultural impact assessment report, with the increased root protection area of at least 16m for Tree 105 and are satisfied that will provide sufficient protection for the roots during development. We are to understand the other veteran tree in the report was mistakenly identified as a veteran tree therefore the usual RPA will suffice.
