Introduction

- I am writing on behalf of South Cambridgeshire District Council (SCDC) [20041387] to submit to the Examining Authority (ExA) matters for Deadline 4 (D4) of the Cambridge Waste Water Treatment Plant Relocation (CWWTPR) Development Consent Order (DCO) Examination.

3. Included within this submission is a revision Local Impact Report for South Cambridgeshire District Council (SCDC). In addition, paragraph 9.37 has been amended to now read moderate adverse effect as opposed to minor/moderate adverse effect.
