Written summary of oral submissions made at Specific Hearing 3 (ISH 3) on the 10th and 11th January 2024 and responses to the Action Points raised.

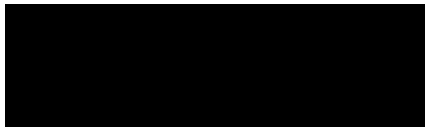
